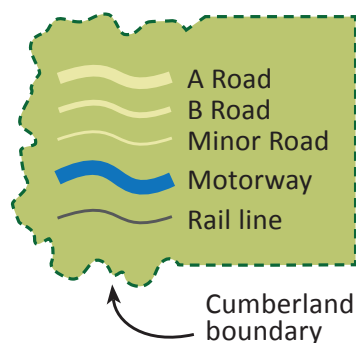

DAY 1

Take your pick from three spectacular golf courses, all offering excellent golfing and post-round refreshment.

1 Brampton Golf Club Tarn Rd, Brampton CA8 1HN

Founded in 1909, this James Braid designed golf course boasts year round play and panoramic countryside views towards the North Pennines and Lake District fells. The 18-hole heathland / moorland course offers something for a range of abilities.

The Braid Restaurant and Bar is a great place to relax after a round of golf, with a rustic menu featuring local produce and home cooked flavours. Booking is advised, particularly for the Sunday lunch, which is very popular!

2 Carlisle Golf Club Aglionby, Carlisle CA4 8AG

Located in undulating parkland on the outskirts of the city, Carlisle Golf Club is a short distance from the M6 motorway making it easy to reach, while maintaining a peaceful atmosphere. Its 18 holes offer golfing for all levels, with mature trees and elegant fairways.

DAY 2

Today's golfing options include views of sea and fells, with courses in the Lakes and coast.

4 Brayton Park Golf Club Aspatria, Wigton CA7 3PY

Located in the grounds of a former country estate, Brayton Park offers a peaceful place to enjoy a round of golf. Open year-round, the 9-hole course offers views of the Lake District fells, with enjoyable golfing for all levels. Once you've finished, the Lakeside Restaurant - located at the heart of the estate - serves dishes centred around Cumbrian produce, with a focus on field to fork dining.

5 Maryport Golf Club Maryport Golf Course, Bank End, Maryport CA15 6PA

With a blend of links and parkland holes in one round, this 18-hole course is located on the Cumbrian coast, with views across the Solway Firth to one side, and the Lake District to the other. Open since 1905, it offers an enjoyable challenge for novice and experienced golfers. A relaxed clubhouse offers food and drink for post round refreshment; check ahead, as pre-orders are welcome.

Established in 1896, this James Braid designed moorland course has stunning views across Skiddaw, the Lorton Fells and Scotland. You can even see the Isle of Man on a fine day. 18 holes await. The clubhouse is open from breakfast through to afternoon tea; a Sunday lunch is also on offer.

DAY 3

Today takes you south along the Cumbrian coastline, where coastal courses offer stunning views and a warm welcome.

8 Whitehaven Golf Club

Red Lonning, Whitehaven CA28 8UD

This American designed course features ponds, woodland, and views of Ennerdale and the surrounding fells. Founded in 2000, there are 18 holes to enjoy - offering something to suit all abilities. There's also a driving range for anyone wanting to perfect their swing. The Lounge Bar serves bar meals and light bites alongside a range of drinks, while the Restaurant offers relaxed dining with picturesque countryside views.



9 St Bees Golf Club

Peck MI, St Bees, CA27 0EJ

On the shores of the Irish sea, this 9-hole course can also be played as 18-holes with alternative tees to be played on from holes 10 - 18. Its cliff top location offers spectacular views, including St Bees Head; while the long par 4, 5th / 14th hole runs along the cliff edge and makes for a challenging hole.

10 Seascale Golf Club

The Banks, Seascale CA20 1QL

Founded in 1893, this traditional links course features a design by Willie Campbell and George Lowe. 18 holes await, with striking views towards the Isle of Man, Scotland and the Lake District fells. The clubhouse offers a good range of food and drink overlooking the coast and the course itself.



11 Silecroft Golf Club

Silecroft LA18 4NX

This delightful 9 hole / 18 tee links course offers an enjoyable walking game, while sea breezes can provide a good challenge for even experienced golfers. As well as views across the Irish sea, you'll also enjoy spotting Barrow-in-Furness and the imposing Black Combe fell to the south and north.
